

There were two Albatros D XI's built. Duplicate the color of Werk No. 2208/18 as follows:

Top of wings and stab: 5-color lozenge, dark

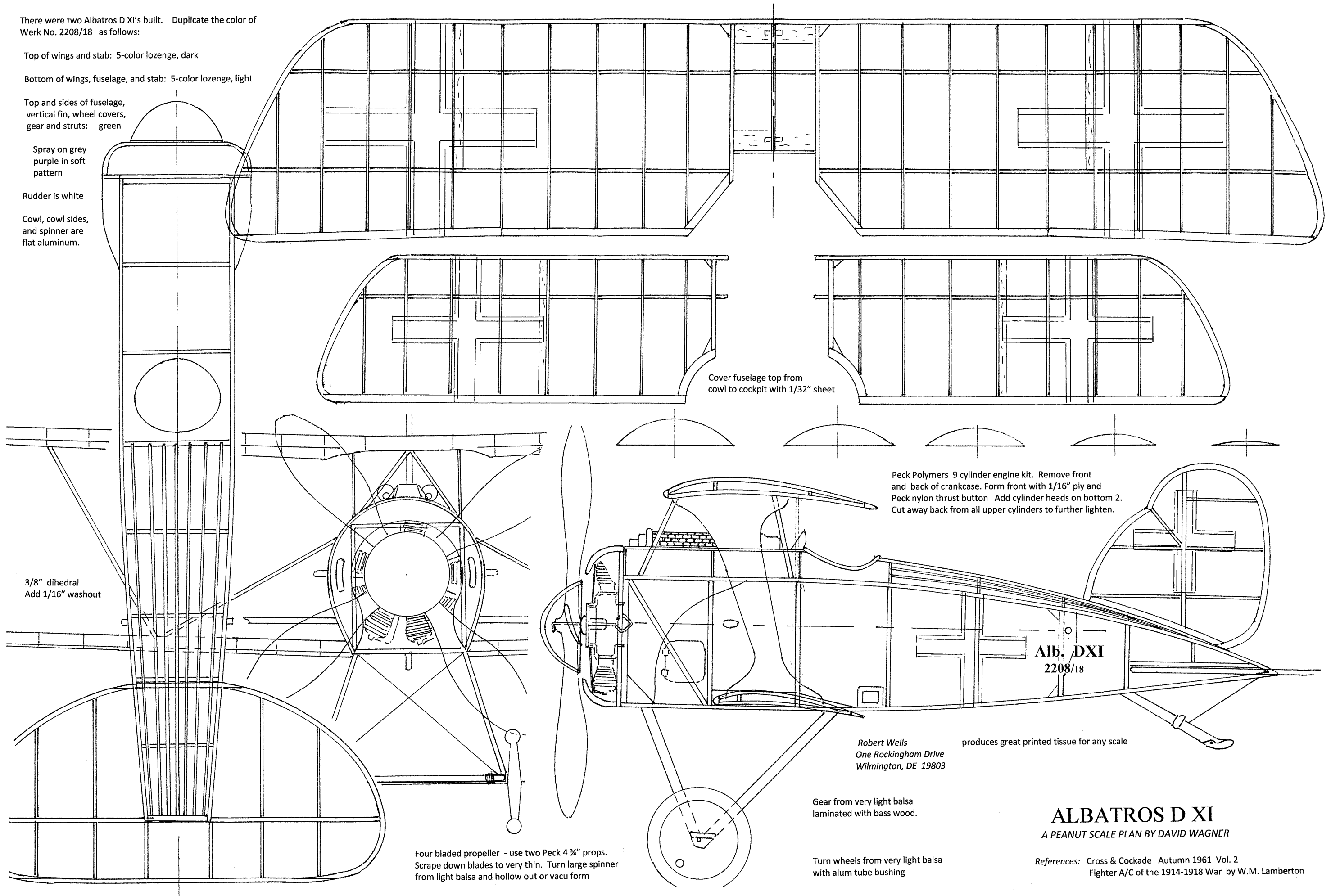
Bottom of wings, fuselage, and stab: 5-color lozenge, light

Top and sides of fuselage, vertical fin, wheel covers, gear and struts: green

Spray on grey purple in soft pattern

Rudder is white

Cowl, cowl sides, and spinner are flat aluminum.



Cover fuselage top from cowl to cockpit with 1/32" sheet

Peck Polymers 9 cylinder engine kit. Remove front and back of crankcase. Form front with 1/16" ply and Peck nylon thrust button. Add cylinder heads on bottom 2. Cut away back from all upper cylinders to further lighten.

3/8" dihedral  
Add 1/16" washout

Four bladed propeller - use two Peck 4 3/4" props. Scrape down blades to very thin. Turn large spinner from light balsa and hollow out or vacu form

Gear from very light balsa laminated with bass wood.

Turn wheels from very light balsa with alum tube bushing
