Some aircraft are outstanding and are destined to become "hall of famers". This we believe is true of the "Mustang," an aircraft which has seen many years of combat duty and one which looks modern even in today's age of jets. It's because of this eye-appeal that we feel it makes an excellent choice for radio control, a choice which has appealed to many.

We first came into contact with this idea of a "Mustang" for R/C through association with Ted Strader's design (the first of a large series which followed).
