Reynold (Ron) Murray was the owner of **Royal Products Corporation** in Denver, Colorado, USA. The company was best known as an importer of R/C items from Japan (e.g. [Marutaka](#) and [Kato](#)) and Europe (circa 1960s to 1980s). From 1967 Ron Murray also held a 50% stake in the company **Royal Electronics Corporation** , which manufactured remote control systems for model aircraft.
